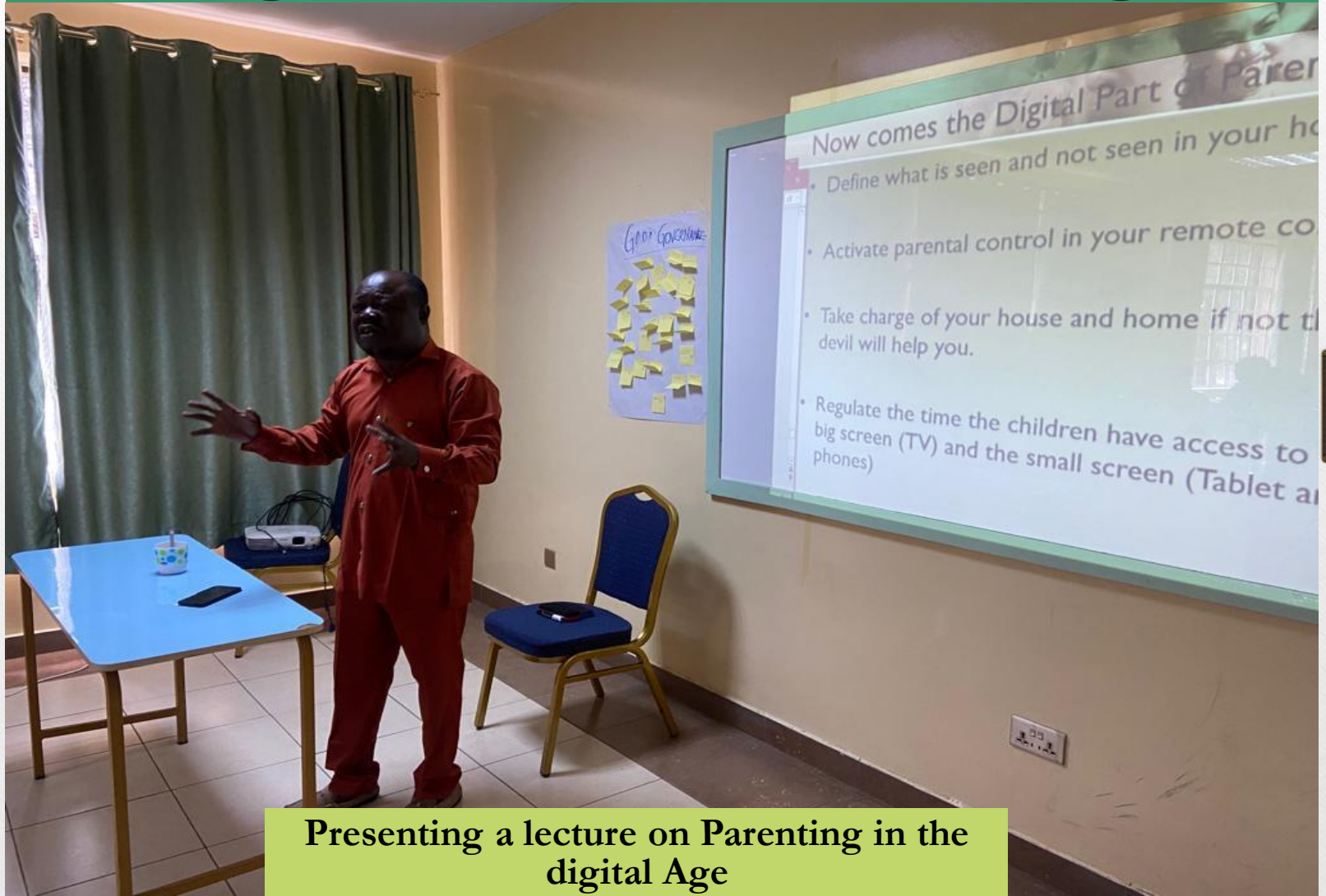

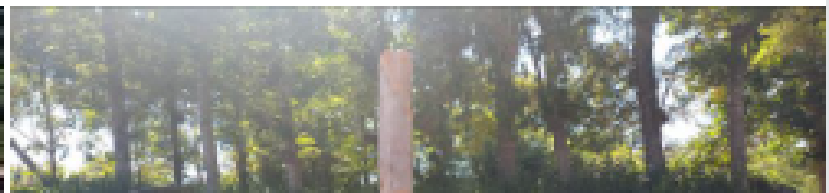
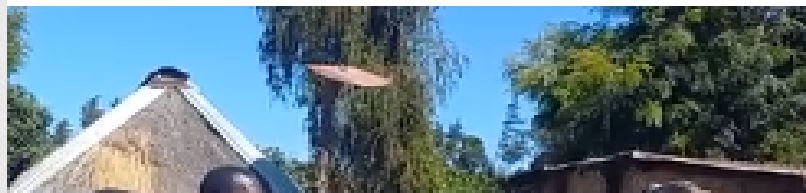
[Emmanuel Biodun Adegoroye](#) spoke to the people about the love of Christ coming from the physical water and the spiritual message.

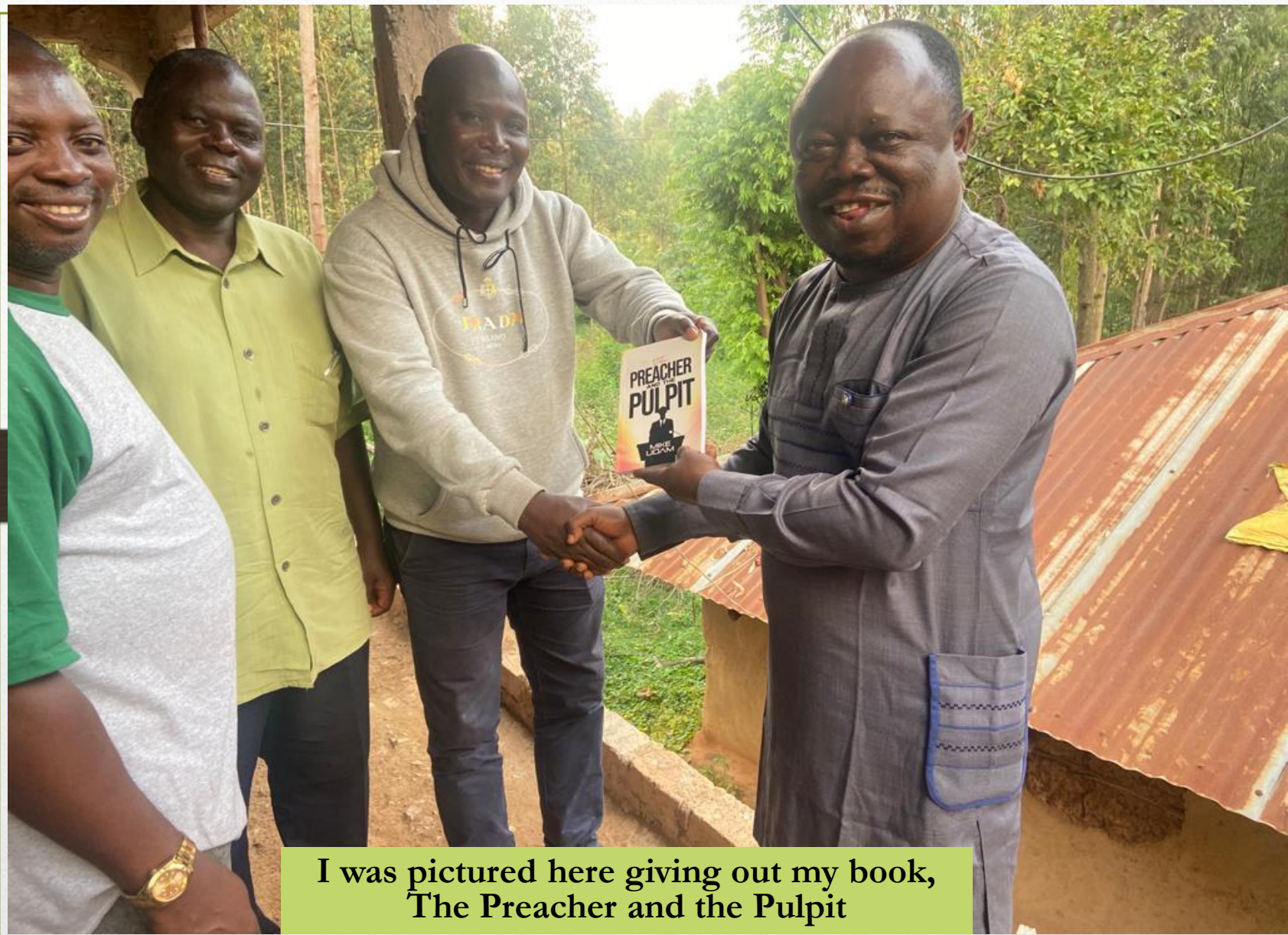

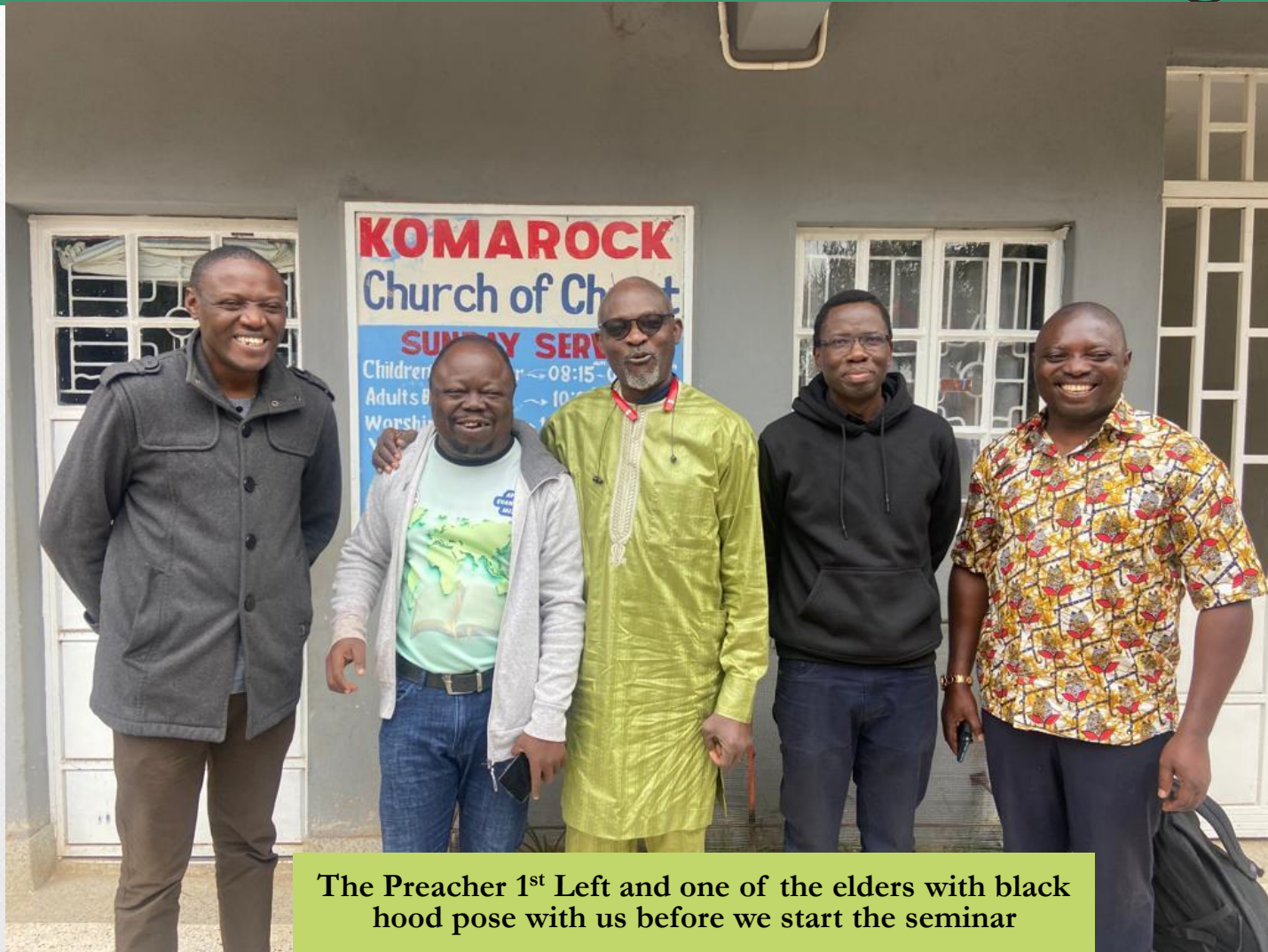

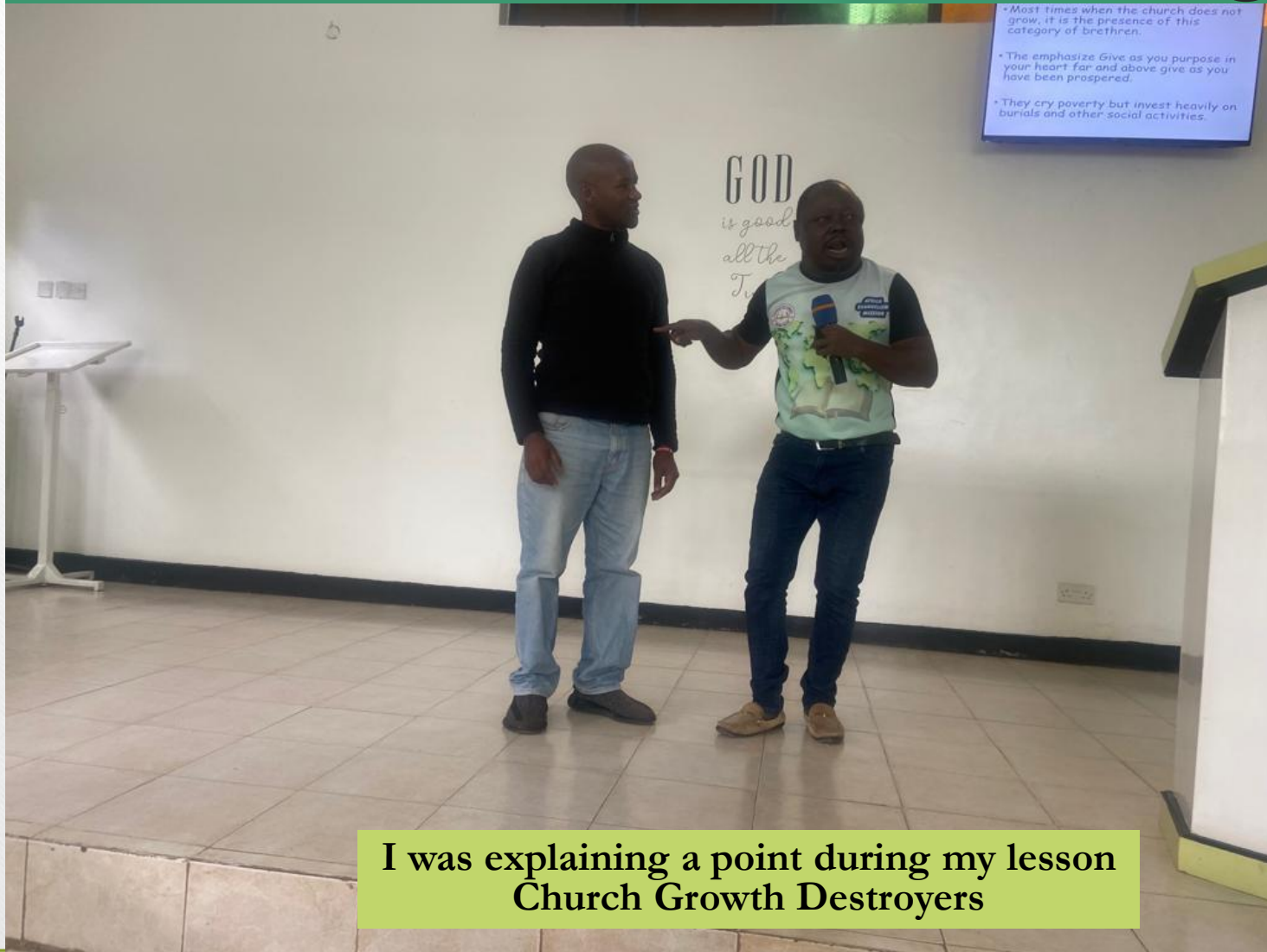
